Czas nieubłaganie podąża do przodu, a my jesteśmy włączeni w nurt wydarzeń i wyzwania jakie Bóg stawia przed nami. Nadszedł czas mojego pożegnania się z Wami. Moja posługa pośród Was trwała stosunkowo krótko, ale ten okres pobytu w San Francisco i pracy kapłańskiej będę bardzo miło wspominał. Tym bardziej to pożegnanie nie jest dla mnie łatwe. Szczególnie cenię sobie zaangażowanie osób którym leży na sercu dobro tej naszej polonijnej Wspólnoty w San Francisco.
